HOW TO REGISTER

Classes in your postgraduate program begin on September 16th, 2019. However, you need to register before the beginning of classes. It is strongly recommended that you come to registration during 15 and 30 August 2019 so that you have a smoother registration process. However, students who cannot come for registration during the registration period will have the right to register until September 6, 2019 at the latest. **Additionally, after completing your registration you are supposed to take the English or/and Turkish Proficiency Exam held in the Campus in order to be exempt from studying one year Turkish or/and English preparatory school before starting to your postgraduate program**

TURKISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY EXAM

DATE AND TIME: SEPTEMBER 9, 2019 AT 14:00 P.M.

Foreign national candidates who graduated from undergraduate or postgraduate programs of universities and desire to be educated at the postgraduate programs in Turkish at Harran University are required to have a Turkish Language Proficiency in order to start their education directly in the related postgraduate program. For a Turkish language proficiency, foreign national student candidates must have at least one of the following conditions;

- To have at least a B level Turkish language proficiency certificate obtained through exams implemented by TOMER or other official equivalent institutions,
- To graduate from undergraduate or postgraduate programs taught in Turkish at home or abroad.

If you do not have at least a B-level Turkish language proficiency certificate or did not graduate from undergraduate or postgraduate programs taught in Turkish at home or abroad, you must gain your Turkish language proficiency through the Turkish Language Proficiency Exam, which will be done by Harran University Turkish Education Application and Research Centre (HRU TOMER) by having a score of at least 50 out of 100.

The exam for Turkish Language Proficiency will be held on September 9, 2019 at 14:00 P.M. at the TÖMER in Harran University. In order to join classes in your postgraduate program with the Turkish language of instruction, it is compulsory that you either submit a valid certificate or get the minimum grade of B from this exam.

Students who fail to fulfil the Turkish Language Proficiency are considered to have 2 (two) semesters leave (this period can be thought of as a preparatory class). Until the end of this period, the student who does not fulfil the language requirement is automatically deregistered from the Graduate School. Also, they cannot take any graduate courses.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY EXAM

DATE AND TIME: SEPTEMBER 10, 2019 AT 14:00 P.M.

Foreign national candidates who graduated from undergraduate or postgraduate programs of universities and desire to be educated at the postgraduate programs in English at Harran University are required to have a Turkish Language Proficiency in order to start their education directly in the related postgraduate program. For a English language proficiency, foreign national student candidates must have at least one of the following conditions;

- To have a score 55 or equivalent from a foreign language exam (e.g YDS) accepted by the Turkish Higher Education Council and Interuniversity Board
- To graduate from undergraduate or postgraduate programs taught in English at home or abroad.

If you do not have a score 55 or equivalent from a foreign language exam (e.g YDS) accepted by the Turkish Higher Education Council and Interuniversity Board or did not graduate from undergraduate or postgraduate programs taught in English at home or abroad, you must gain your English language proficiency through the English Language Proficiency Exam, which will be done by Harran University Foreign Language College by having a score of at least 55 out of 100. The exam for English Language Proficiency will be held on September 10, 2019 at 14:00 P.M. at the Foreign Language College in Harran University. In order to join classes in your postgraduate program with the English language of instruction, it is compulsory that your either submit a valid certificate or get the minimum score of 55 from this exam. Students who fail to fulfil the English Language Proficiency are considered to have 2 (two) semesters leave (this period can be thought of as a preparatory class). Until the end of this period, the student who does not fulfil the language requirement is automatically deregistered from the Graduate School. Also, they cannot take any graduate courses. Moreover, the foreign candidates of doctoral postgraduate programs in Turkish are also required to have a English language proficiency certificate.
